IQ[™] Cloud Setup Instructions

You have purchased a Rain Bird IQ Cellular cartridge with pre-activated cellular service for one year included. Please follow the below steps to begin using.

Step 1: Insert the IQ cartridge according to the cartridge instructions included in the box. At the LX Controller, configure the IQ Cellular Cartridge as a Direct, Server, or Client Satellite. Unless you are sharing the cartridge communication with other controllers, select Direct (99% of all setup is Direct). If the communication is being shared with other controllers, select Server. If this is using the communication of another cartridge, then select client. For more about client/server communication options, please visit www.rainbird.com/ig



Step 2a. Visit rainbird.com/iq Click IQ Cloud Sign Up and complete account registration.

Step 2b. Return to rainbird.com/iq and click Login.



Step 2: Click configure this computer. This only needs to be done once. If you access IQ Cloud from a different computer, please remember to do this step again.



Step 3: A file will download. Click open/run. Depending on security settings and the version of Windows a security warning may display. Click run.

Step 4: Configuration takes 1 second. Now press Login. A file will download. Click open/run. Enter the username and password you created on the registration page. The first login will require you to set an account security question and answer.

Step 6: Under satellites, click add, and select the correct LX Controller model that the IQ Cellular Cartridge is installed in. Then select whether this is a Direct, Server, or Client. This should match the selection made in step 1.

Then enter the ip address that is printed on the cartridge (pictured below). This sticker may be on the front or back of the cartridge
