Weather stations provide a wide range of local weather information on a daily basis that can be used to manage irrigation at a site or across a number of sites.

Irrigation control systems can use this information to determine how much water has been lost at a site through evaporation and plant use, and adjust irrigation to only apply the amount of water required to meet plant water needs.

This method of irrigation, called evapotranspiration scheduling, reduces the chance of over or under watering allowing plants to be maintained in an optimum or desired condition.
